

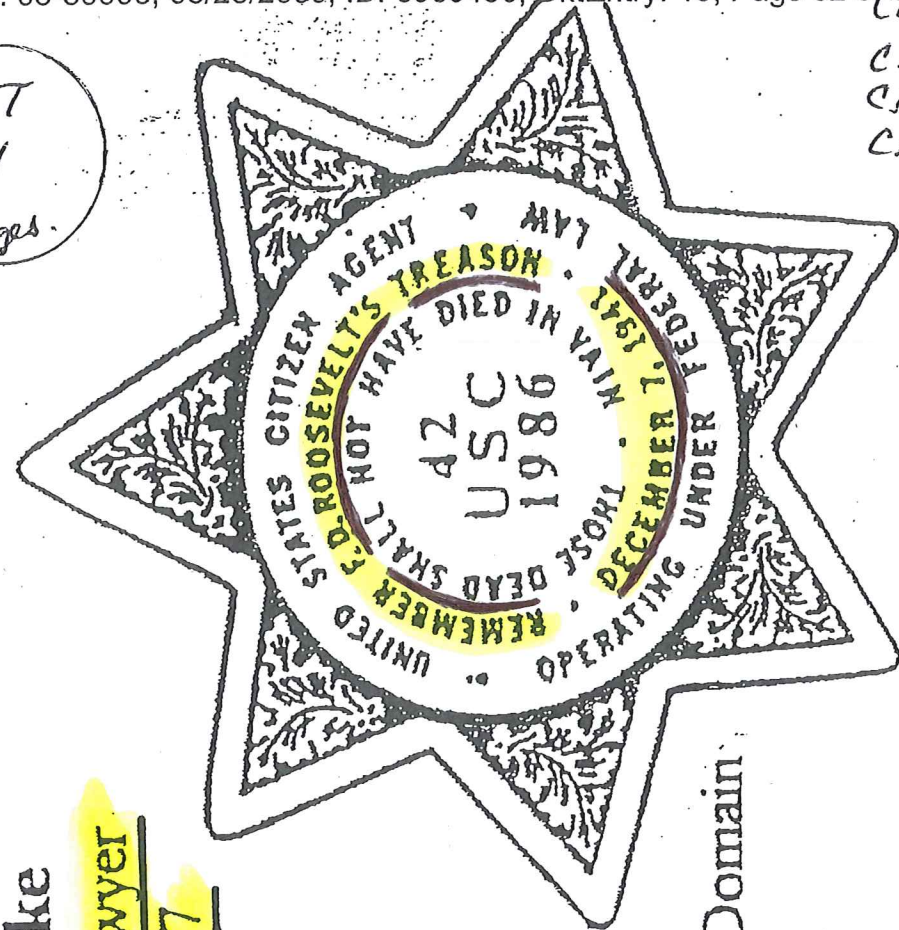

> In the year 1996, officers of the United States Government crossed the jurisdictional boundaries of the government of Washington State and raided a 4th of July party attended by Mr. Pitner, a member of the unorganized militia of the Washington State, a military function of Washington State subject only to the Governor of Washington State, established in behalf of the People of Washington State. The presence of U.S. Govt officers at that party was a violation of States Rights.

> Among the other guests at the party was a lectures on U.S. Constitutional law, Tracy Lee Brown, a very religious man devoted to the principles in the Constitution for the United States of America, and the government of this Nation by that Constitution and the laws pursuant thereto. Others present at that party were the owners of the house and their friends.

> One of the people was a mentally retarded man playing with sparklers at the time of the arrest. Two or three of the men were attempting to construct a pipe bomb, a dangerous project for rank amateurs, because one spark from screwing the device together could result in an explosion. This project was being engaged in for entertainment purposes only. It was not a threat to anyone except the people doing the experiment.

> In all, nine people, including the retarded male playing with sparklers and two of the wives at the party, were arrested.

What relief are you seeking? I WANT TO APPEAL MY CONVICTION. I did not commit a crime. No accusers were named. No charges were defined. Only the prosecutor presented at the trial. Defense was not allowed. (See the MOTION IN LIMINE). The Appeal was filed Jan 23, 2003, but suppressed by the Judge. The Appeals Court officers changed the Appeal Court Case number three times from CA03-30006 to 30350 to 30361, and forced an Atty. Robt A. Weppner, upon me without my consent.
