


# Another Gas Station? NO!

Proposed Location: 5300 Sebastopol Road (Llano Road & Highway 12)



Do we have a climate crisis or don't we?

How much "convenience" do we need?



## Why not?

- There is no need for a gas station in this location. The Chevron station is just down the road and there are about 7 other stations within a 5-mile radius
- Existing local businesses would be evicted
- It is immediately adjacent to the Joe Rodota Trail
- The location is in a priority groundwater basin, do we need more underground storage tanks at risk of leaking?
- The location is in the Laguna de Santa Rosa within California tiger salamander Critical Habitat
- We are in the midst of a climate crisis and should be finished building 20<sup>th</sup> century fossil fuel infrastructure
